The 15<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Interfaces and Human Computer Interaction (IHCI 2021) (part of the IADIS 15<sup>th</sup> Multi Conference on Computer Science and Information Systems 2021) was held virtually due to the COVID-19 pandemic, during 21-23 July 2021.

This conference was organized by the International Association for Development of the Information Society (IADIS).

This conference addressed the main issues of concern within Interface Culture and Design with a particular emphasis on the affective aspects of design, development and implementation of interfaces and the generational implications for design of human and technology interaction. This conference aimed to explore and discuss innovative studies of technology and its application in interfaces and welcomes research in progress, case studies, practical demonstrations and workshops in addition to the traditional submission categories.

This edition was published jointly with the 14<sup>th</sup> International Conference on Game and Entertainment Technologies 2021. These events received 145 submissions from more than 23 countries. Each submission was anonymously reviewed by an average of five independent reviewers, to ensure that accepted submissions were of a high standard. Consequently, only 25 full papers were published. The overall acceptance rate corresponded to about 17%.
